Primarily the main aim of the classes is create an environment of enjoyment and fun. Children achieve so much more when they are happy.

Classes are £4.50 per session, payable every half term.

The classes are run as close to the school terms as possible.

It is not necessary to purchase a uniform straight away but it is preferred that your child has one after the first half term if possible. Please see our website for the uniform requirements.

THE UNIFORM

MODERN & TAP

Pre-Primary – Grade 1 Tap

Grade 1-3 Modern

- Pinch-front leotard 'Angela' in Vert Green or Raspberry.
- Black, footless-tights or hot pants.
- Black tap shoes with heel and toe taps and black socks.
- Black, cotton wrap crossover cardigan (optional).

Grade 2-3 Tap

Grade 4 Modern

- 'Jill' polo-neck Leotard in Delphinium Purple.
- Tan footless-tights and black hot pants.
- Black full-lace tap shoes and black socks.



Grade 4-5 Tap

Grade 5-6 Modern

- ISTD regulation leotard.
- Hipster, matt-nylon shorts, worn with tan, convertible tights.
- Black, full-lace tap shoes and black socks.

BALLET

Baby – Primary

- Plum-colour, ISTD regulation leotard.
- Pink ballet socks.
- Pink-leather ballet shoes with elastic (order one size larger than usual). Use Bloch Arise, unless you

need a smaller size than available)

- Matching chiffon circular skirt.
- Black cotton wrap crossover cardigan (optional).

Grade 1

- Plum-colour, ISTD regulation leotard.
- Pink ballet tights.
- Pink-leather ballet shoes with elastic (order one size larger than usual).
- Matching wrap skirt.
- Black, cotton wrap crossover cardigan (optional).

Grades 2 - 3

- 'Helena' Leotard in Aqua.
- Pink ballet tights.
- Pink ballet shoes with elastic.
- Black, cotton wrap crossover cardigan (optional).

Grade 4 & 5

- Black 'So Danca' boat-neck, lace-top leotard.
- Pink ballet tights.
- Pink, canvas, split-sole ballet shoes.



Boys

- White, scoop-neck leotard.
- Black shorts or leggings.
- Black ballet shoes.
- Black socks.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FEES

All classes are payable *before* term starts. Without prior arrangement, failure to do so will lose the student's place. **Students will not be able to take part in lessons if payment has not been made.**

Fees are non-refundable.

There is a £5 late payment fee which will be added if fees are more than 2 weeks late.

As costs are fixed, fees remain payable in cases of absence.

Fees will be reviewed annually.

UNIFORM

All pupils must wear the correct uniform for each class. Hair must be tied back at all times. Ballet students should endeavour to wear their hair in a bun.

DISCIPLINE

Pupils are expected to conduct themselves in a disciplined manner whilst attending classes and be respectful to both teachers and fellow pupils at all times. This will ensure the safety and well being of everyone.

If a child is causing disruption, they will be asked to leave their lesson.

NOTICE TO LEAVE

Half a term's written notice or payment in lieu is required if you wish to withdraw your child from classes.

GENERAL INFORMATION
